1. If you open it, close it.
2. If you turn it on, turn it off.

7. If you make a mess, clean it up.
8. If it belongs to someone else, get permission to use it.
9. If you don't know how to operate it, leave it alone.
10. If it's none of your business, don't ask questions.
11. If it's not yours, don't touch it.
